CHW Workforce Development Bridge to Excellence

- Program is certified by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and provides 160 contact hours towards certification
- Participants will learn the basic eight core competencies of a community health worker and applications of these competencies in a community and healthcare Environment
- CHWs will acquire skills in outreach, patient navigation, follow-up services, community health education, informal counseling, social support, advocacy, and participation in clinical research.
- Who can become a CHW?
 - Everyday people who want to make a difference
 - Anyone at least 18 years old
 - High school diploma or GED is required
- Registration Fee
 - Per Participant: \$500.00
 - Payment options: Full \$500 or 5 months at \$100
 - Discounts to employers training 2 or more employees
