- Established in 2004, the program has housed hundreds of health professions students.
- The majority of the students are training to become physicians or physician assistants.
- Students usually stay with housing sponsors for 2 to 6 weeks.

## **Housing Requirements**

During the student's clinical rotations, we ask the housing sponsor to donate the following:

- A private bedroom
- Access to a full bathroom
- Access to a full-functioning kitchen

**Students are responsible for his/her own linens and meals.**

**All students are required to abide by the house rules.**
