PRE-BUSINESS:

Students must complete these courses with a grade of "C" or better before declaring a Business major: ENGL 1301; MATH 1324 and 1325; COMM 1321 or ENGL 1302; ECON 2301 and 2302; CIDM 1315 or equivalent; ACCT 2301.

PREREQUISITE NOTES:

ACCT 2302: ACCT 2301.

BUSI 3312: junior standing.

BUSI 3319: MGT 3330, MKT 3340, and junior standing.

CIDM 2342: MATH 1325 or permission of instructor.

CIDM 3330: CIDM 2342 or concurrent enrollment.

ECON Advanced Elective: ECON 2301 and ECON 2302.

ECON 4341: ECON 2301 and ECON 2302.

ENGL 1302 and 2311: ENGL 1301.

FIN 3320: ACCT 2301, 2302 or concurrent enrollment, and CIDM 2342 or concurrent enrollment.

FIN 4323: FIN 3320 or consent of instructor.

MATH 1324: MATH 0303 or a score of 85 or higher on the Accuplacer Elementary Algebra exam.

MATH 1325: MATH 1324 (or 1314 if student already has credit).

MGT 4311: junior standing.

MGT 4315: FIN 3320, MGT 3330, MKT 3340, and senior standing.

MGT 4335: MGT 3330 and senior standing.

MKT 4340: MKT 3340.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

¹ **COB Writing Core:** Choose one course from: BUSI 1304 (prerequisite: ENGL 1302/2311); BUSI/MGT 4380; CIDM 3320; ECON 4342 (prerequisites are ECON 2301 and 2302); FIN 3350 (prerequisite is FIN 3320), 4320 (prerequisite is FIN 3320), 4321 (prerequisite is FIN 4320); MGT 3335 (prerequisite is junior standing). Major requirements will not count for the Writing Component.

² **Elective Area of Specialization:** nine advanced hours from one of these areas: ACCT, CIDM, ECON, FIN, MGT, or MKT.

³ **International Elective:** Must come from HIST or POSC at the 4000 level.
