**PREREQUISITE NOTES:**

- AGBE 2317: prerequisite is 15 semester hours.
- AGBE 3301: prerequisite is AGBE 2317 or six semester hours of economics.
- AGBE 3302: prerequisite is AGBE 2317 or six semester hours of economics.
- AGBE 3304: prerequisite is junior standing.
- AGRI 3318: prerequisite is MATH 1314 or 1324.
- AGRI 4103: prerequisite is senior standing.
- ANSC 3374: prerequisite is ANSC 1319 or consent of instructor.
- ENGL 1302 or 2311: prerequisite is ENGL 1301.
- MATH 1314 and 1324: prerequisite is MATH 0303 or a score of 85 or higher on Accuplacer elementary level math.
- PSES 4342: prerequisite is PSES 3411.
- PSES 4330: prerequisite is PSES 1307 or 4 semester hours of biology.
- PSES 4371: prerequisite is PSES 2313 or BIOL 3510.
- PSES 4341: prerequisite is junior standing or consent of instructor.

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

- <sup>1</sup> CHEM/PHYS Requirement: Choose from—CHEM 1411 and 1412 or CHEM 1415 and PHYS 1401.
- <sup>2</sup> PSES Requirement: PSES 4330, 4341, 4342 and 4371 are all courses that are offered only once every other year; therefore, students should take these courses whenever they offered during their junior and senior years.
- <sup>3</sup> AGBE 3301, 3302, 3304: 3302 and either 3301 or 3304 are required. AGBE 3302 is typically offered in both fall and spring, but AGBE 3301 is typically fall only and 3304 spring only.
- <sup>4</sup> Both AGRI 3318 and either AGRI 1329 or ANSC 3318 are required, but AGRI 3318 may be taken in either the fall or spring semester.
- <sup>5</sup> Selectives and Electives:
  - Selectives: Select 19 to 21 hours from PSES 4302, 4310, 4321, 4331, 4398; BIOL 2420, 3311, 3510, 3532, 4510, 4513; AGRI 4310. A minimum of 12 hours selected must be PSES.
  - Electives: Take 13-18 (or however many are needed to total 120 overall) in any subject, lower- or advanced-level.
