## NOTES:

**FOUNDATION CORE** is the goal during the freshman year for an art major.

- ARTS 1311 (two-dimensional design) and ARTS 1316 (drawing I) plus one of the art history courses (1303 or 1304) in the fall semester.
- ARTS 1312 (three-dimensional design) and ARTS 1317 (drawing II) plus one of the art history courses in the spring semester.
- ARTS 1303 and 1304 do NOT have to be taken in sequence. If developmental courses are needed, ARTS 1303/1304 can be delayed.

## 3INTERMEDIATE CORE:

- Completion of the FOUNDATION CORE (ARTS 1311, 1312, 1316, 1317, 1303, 1304) is the prerequisite for all INTERMEDIATE CORE courses.
- Transfer students who do not have the foundation core completed must see an instructor of an intermediate core course to get blue-carded into the course.
- Take three courses from three areas:
  - ARTS 2316 (Painting I, fall/spring) or ARTS 2366 (Watermedia I, spring) 0
