** While MATH 1332 will fulfill core math requirements, it will NOT prepare students for math beyond MATH 1332 such as Plane Trigonometry (MATH 1316), Pre-Calculus (MATH 2412), etc.

*** Or an equivalent course (second year, second semester) in French or German.

NOTE I: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU, and 30 of the 39 hours must be the final hours counted toward a degree. A maximum of 60 semester hours in art can be counted toward a degree.

NOTE II: Art majors (B.A. or B.S.) interested in gallery management, museum work or other art/business possibilities should normally select Studio Art and Management or Art History Emphasis and take support courses in ACCT 2301, 2302, BUSI 1301, MKT 3340, MGT 3330, 3332 (prerequisites: ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302 and FIN 3320).

Note: This is NOT a degree plan. Before completion of 60 hours, students are allowed and encouraged to request an official degree plan in the office of the dean of the Sybil B. Harrington College of Fine Arts and Humanities, located in Mary Moody Northern Hall, Room 161 (or call 651-2777). After completing 60 hours, students will not be allowed to progress without requesting a degree plan.
